Elizabeth Blackwell was born in England in 1821 and moved to New York City when she was ten years old. One day she decided that she wanted to become a doctor. **That** was nearly impossible for a woman in the middle of the nineteenth century. After writing many letters **seeking** admission to medical schools, she was finally accepted by a doctor in Philadelphia. So determined was she that she taught at school and gave music lessons to earn money for her tuition.

In 1849, after graduation from medical school, she decided to further her education in Paris. She wanted to be a surgeon, but a serious eye infection forced her to abandon the idea.

Upon returning the United States, Elizabeth and her sister, also a doctor, along with another female doctor, managed to open a new hospital, the first for women and children. Besides being the first female doctor in the United States and founding her own hospital, she also opened the first medical school for women.
